GEORGE WILLIAM BANCKER

Died in New York City intestate in 1852.  
Son of Abraham Boelen and Ariantje (Mantius or Mancius)  
Bancker. Baptised August 12, 1781.

From the Bancker Genealogy:

" George William, baptised Aug.12 1781, was son of Abraham Boelen Bancker of Kingston. His mother was Ariantje Mantius or Marcius,"

A miscellaneous note in the back of the book says,

" George W. Bancker died in New York City, intestate in 1852"

Note: The above information is not satisfactory as the genealogy does not state definitely that this boy went to Union. However, the age, the locality from which he came, the similar name even to spelling, and the fact that he had a brother two years younger, whose name was Evert A. makes the coincidence so strong that I feel positive that this man is an Union alumnus.

The genealogy gives considerable information about the father but simply mentions the names of the boys and the date, that they were baptised. It also says "No further trace of this family was made". R.T. Oct. 14 1932)
