Robert Bronk

Rev. Robert Bronk became pastor in 1814 (of the Reformed Dutch church, known as the Bight Church of Watervliet, N. Y.), and also ministered to the church of Washington and Gibbonsville. He resigned in 1823, having been pastor nine years.
