Married Sarah Jane Taylor (daughter of John W. Taylor, Union 1803) who was born February 27, 1808, and educated at Miss Willard's Seminary, Troy, N. Y., in 1825.

He was born in 1802; a graduate of Union College. He was a man of great intelligence and culture, with singular honesty and simplicity of character. In 1838 they removed to Cleveland, Ohio.

Ten children were born to them, of whom all but two have died between 15 and 20 years of age: Mary Jane and Sarah Louise have spent many years in Europe in travelling. They reside in New York or Lakewood, N.J. Their mother died in 1857.

Mr. Beattie died in 1861 in New York.
