AMOS BILLINGS BEACH.

Was elected Rector in 1838 (Zion Church, Episcopal) Butternuts, Otsego Co., N. Y., and served for twelve years. He was the son of the Rev. Stephen Beach of East Haddam, Connecticut. He was a graduate of Union College, Schenectady, in 1832, and after of the General Theological Seminary in 1836. After leaving Butternuts he served as rector at Binghamton, Oswego, and Ithaca. He died January 15, 1885, at the age of seventy years.
