Son of Alfred and Olive (Child) Bosworth was born in Greenfield, New York, October 7, 1801; died at McHenry, Ill., Sept. 8, 1843; married at Buffalo, N. Y. January 12, 1832, Almira Smith; (2) Elizabeth Nixon.

Benjamin Franklin Bosworth was a graduate of Union College, Schenectady, N.Y., studied law, but never practiced; studied medicine and practiced for a time at Boston, Erie Co., N. Y., then went in 1839 to Illinois and "was a successful merchant until his death." He was a man of broad and generous ideas, of sound judgment and of ripe and thorough culture.
