89-90 GEORGE W. CODWISE, '22, Feb 7, '21,
was born in Santa Cruz, Danish West Indies, September 9th, 1800, but was
brought to New York city in boyhood for his education. In College he
was a Philomathean. He studied medicine in Albany, and entered the U.

S. Navy in 1825 as Assistant Surgeon; became a Surgeon in 1828, and a
Medical Director in 1873 with the relative rank of Commodore. When not
cruising, he resided in New York, Philadelphia, Memphis, Tenn., York, Pa.,
at which latter place he was retired after fifty-seven years of service. The
last eighteen years of his life were spent in Grantville (now Wellesley Hills),
Mass. He was a Republican and a member of the Episcopal Church. He
died in Wellesley Hills, May 2d, 1884, leaving a widow and four children.
