Son of Abraham and Margaret (Lansing) Oothout Born June 30, 1780.

Married Eliza Ann Nicoll, a lineal descendant of Colonel Nicoll, the first English Governor of the Provonce of New York.

Mr. Oothout was an attorney-at-law, for many years residing and practicing his profession at Albany. During the latter years of his life, returning to Schenectady, he retired from professional practice, and died at his homestead June 27, 1846. His excellent widow, died at the residence of her son, in the city of Rochester, January 22, 1872, in the 85th year of her age.
