Son of Sunderland and Mary (Andrus) Sears.
Born June 10, 1781
Died St. Louis, Mo., May 12, 1846, aged 65.
Married November 12, 1812, Hannah Gregory, daughter
of Col. Ulrich and Tamar (Rowland) Gregory, of Ballston
Centre, N. Y. She was born June 6, 1781 and died at
St. Louis, Mo., June 28, 1847, aged 66.

Children:

1. Elizabeth, born Feb. 20, 1815; died Aug. 3, 1822
2. Sunderland Gregory, born Saratoga, N.Y., Sept. 27, 1817.
3. Henry W. born St. Louis, Mo., Mar. 21, 1822; married and died, leaving two sons.

William Sears was a physician, and practiced in St. Louis, Mo.
