Son of Rev. Abraham Van Horne and Anna Covenhoven.
Born Nov. 12, ~~1803~~

He graduated from Union College and soon after married Anna Elizabeth Yost on Oct. 26, 1826. In 1833 he decided to follow his brother and two sisters to Will Co., Ill., where he purchased a large tract of state land near what is known to-day as Frankfort, and some of his property still belongs to members of his family. He died Jan. 31, 1867, and his wife died on Feb. 1, 1862
