David Wihliam Elmore, born in Chatham, N.Y., Feb. 3, 1800. Graduated from Union College. (Date not known. Family records say with degree of M.A.) Graduated Newton Theological Seminary 1824. (This is their record. It seems rather early. This was Newton's first class.)

Held pastorates in New York state. Settled at St. Charles, Ill. in 1836. Organized many churches in that section. Died July 29, 1854 at St. Charles, Ill. (Killed by lightening.)
