MARSHALL L. FARNSWORTH

Was born in Hawley, Mass about 1799, and removed to Madison Co., N. Y., when about eighteen years of age; graduated at Union in 1825; studied theology at Auburn; was licensed and ordained as an Evangelist in Western New York, and preached there till failureof health constrained him to seek warmer climate of South Carolina; in 1829 preached in Danby, N. Y.; was then pastor of the church (Congregational) in Elmira, N. Y., about three years; labored a year or two as an agent of the American Sunday School Union in Connecticut; then taught a select school in Norwich, Conn.,; and, in 1838, was constrained by failing health to relinguish active service, and he removed to the residence of his father-in-law, Mr. Jonathan B. Gosman, in Danby, N. Y., where he died, November 27, 1838, in the fortieth year of his age. Rev. William Clark, pastor of the church in that place, performed the funeral services. On his tombstone is the inscription, "I have kept the faith." His widow married Mr. James O. Towne of Albany, N. Y.
