At the request of my brother, James W. Veeder, I answer your inquiry concerning our grandfather, Matthew Ten Eyck Veeder, of the class of 1808, for your Alumni record.

Matthew Ten Eyck Veeder was born at Schenectady, May 21, 1788. He was the son of Gerrit S. Veeder, of Schenectady, and Jane Ten Eyck, of Ulster County, New York. After graduating from Union in 1808 he was admitted to the New York Bar. In 1812 he married Maria DeWitt, of Ulster County, New York, who died June 9, 1824. He died at Schenectady June 9, 1824, and was buried in the family burying ground at Veeder's Mills, and was afterwards removed to Vale Cemetery.


Gentlemen:

Matthew L. Veeder was a graduate of Union College class of 1808. He was born at Schenectady, May 21, 1788, the son of Gerrit S. Veeder and Jane Ten Eyck. He was admitted to the New York State Bar. He died at Schenectady, June 9, 1824, and was buried in the family burying ground at Veeder's Mills but was afterwards removed to Vale Cemetery in Schenectady. In 1812 he married Maria DeWitt.

Most of this information was obtained from Mr. Van Vechten Veeder, 27 William Street, New York City. It was written in 1931, and we do not know whether Mr. Veeder is still living.
