HENRY PIERREPONT EDWARDS

Born in 1809; died in New York City, February 24, 1855.

Was a leneal descendant of Reverend Jonathan Edwards and son of Henry Waggaman Edwards, governor of Connecticut and United States Senator from that state. He served for seven years as judge of the Supreme Court of New York, ranking high for legal and judicial ability.
