KILLIAN V. R. LANSING

Born at Albany, November 23, 1794.
 Died at Albany, December 18, 1874.
 Son of Abraham A., born August 4, 1752; died Feb. 21, 1822; married Sept. 3, 1774, Elsie Van Rensselaer, born Feb. 6, 1757; died March 1, 1796.

Prepared for college with Rev. Ammi R. Robbins of Norfolk, Conn., and entered Williams College, where he remained for a time but completed his studies at Union College. He studied medicine at Philadelphia and commenced to practice in Amber, N. Y.. In 1834 removed to Randolph, N. Y., where he continued in practice until 1850, when he retired from practice owing to ill-health. He was eminently successful both as a physician and surgeon--particularly the latter,--being frequently summoned to cases 50 miles or more from his home. He spent the latter years of his life at his old home in Albany, N. Y., where he died.
