TRACY F. HOPKINS.

Son of Rhoderick and Mary Seymour Hopkins

Born at New Hartford, Conn., 1791

Married Betsey Townsend

He died at Holland Patent, N. Y., December 8, 1851, aged 60 years.

He resided in Holland Patent, N. Y. After his death the widow and the surviving children removed to Westmoreland, N. Y., where they resided until all the children died, removed to Rensselaer Co. The family were stricken with tuberculosis.
