WILLIAM H. FONDEY.

Died: In Elizabethtown, N. J., on the 24th. inst., William H. Fonday, of this city, in the 31st. year of his age. Although called from among us thus early in life, Mr. Fonday had already fulfilled a part in this community, of no ordinary responsibility and usefulness. His intellect, naturally acute and vigorous, had been disciplined and refined by the subsequent continuance of liberal and classical studies. In the discharge of his professional duties, he was distinguished no less for his ability than for his marked faithfulness and punctuality, and these qualities, combined as they were with purity of morals, refinement of taste and feelings, strict integrity and uncommon energy and decision of character, rendered him a most valuable member of society. His early religious impressions, which had always been silently influential upon his character, ripened during the last year into a distinct and open profession of christian faith, and his calm reliance upon it sustained and tranquillized him, amid the trials incident to illness in a foreign land, and through the sufferings which immediately preceded his death. -
