

I have your favor of June 27. The record which you give of Heman H. Haff is as accurate as I can give it from my own personal knowledge except as to the following additional details:

Name in full, Heman Henry Haff. Graduate at Union College 1824, A.B., attended Colgate University, Hamilton, New York, 1824-25. His father's name was Joshua Haff, who lived in Nassau, Rensselaer County, New York; his mother's name was Sarah Green. He was born October 6, 1802 and died at Grundy Center, Iowa, September 1, 1868. He was married to Sarah Tarbell (not Farbell) in Stillwater, New York, September 20, 1832, by the Reverend J. Fletcher of Saratoga. His wife was born in Chester, Vermont, September 30, 1808 and died January 3, 1852 at East Mendon, New York. The following is a list of his children with dates and places of birth:

I understand that he received a degree of A. M. but am not sure about the college. You have it down as Union and Middlebury. He was an ordained minister of the Baptist Church and was ordained in Stillwater on February 1, 1832. Was originally licensed at Schenectady in August, 1824. He had no military title and so far as 4 know held no public offices. I do not know to what professional or other societies he may have belonged, or that he had any literary productions. He had the following brothers and sisters: Jacob Haff, William E. Haff, Horace Haff, Sarah Haff and Imily Haff. All together with himself were children of Joshua Haff of Nassau, New York.

As to the Reverend Franklin R. Haff, I can only say that I met him at Oshkosh, Wisconsin many years ago, that he had a son who lived at

Y.; Augusta, Springfield, West Schuyler, Seneca Falls, Mendon, and Henrietta. Two years agent of Baptist Publication Society. From 1854 to 1858 taught in Paw Paw, Ill. The preached to feeble churches in Illinois and Iowa. He died at Grundy Center, Iowa, Spetember 1, 1868.
