CHARLES THORP GILBERT

Was sent to boarding school at Hamilton, N. Y., and from there went to Union College, where he won the honor of membership in the Phi Beta Kappa Society. After graduation in accordance with his father's wishes, he took the course at the Yale Divinity school, but, being a man of liberal thought, he refused to sign the "Thirty-Nine Articles" and was never ordained. He afterwards became a banker at Marshall, Michigan, and from there went to New York where he lived until his death.

He was a son of Joseph T. and Hannah (Thorp) Gilbert.
