LINUS NORTH

Second son of Stephen and Susan (Savage) North was born at Fly Creek, Otsego Co., New York, November 2, 1794 and died at Palmyra, New York, January 24, 1846.

He married at Cooperstown, New York, October 26, 1819, Justa Maria Fitch, who was born March 3, 1800, and died at Ann Arbor, Michigan, June 3, 1883.

Rev. Linus North studied for the ministry at Auburn Theological Seminary, Auburn, New York, and was ordained, but his health failed him, and he lost his voice to such an extent that he was unable to preach. He then studied medicine at Hobart College, Geneva, New York with the intention of becoming a foreign missionary. But he was not able to carry out his plans, as his health steadily failed, ending in his death. His home was at Palmyra, New York, where all of his children were born.
