DANIEL H. MARSH

Admitted in 1827, practiced here throughout his life, which terminated not many years ago. He held several positions of trust, and was considered a reliable counselor. Soon after he came he was a partner of Benjamin Nott, son of the celebrated President Nott of Union College, and the firm was quite prominent.

Daniel H. Marsh was at the date of his death, Aug. 15, 1876, the oldest practicing member of the bar of this county. He was then 71 years of age, a native of Schenectady Co., and graduated from Union College in 1824. He was admitted to the bar in 1827 and settled in Oswego the same year. At different periods he was a partner with a son of Dr. Nott, of Schenectady, with Joseph C. Wright, Albertus Perry, and Silas H. Webb. He never held office except county clerk one term. He was a man of ability in his profession and much respected by the community. p. 263
