## HENRY ROSE

Was born in Virginia in 1802 Married in 1832, Sarah L., sister of Mrs. John N. Rose. She was born in New York City in 1801. They took up their residence in Jerusalem in 1836, on lands (500 acres) adjoining those of John N. Rose on the east. He purchased several smaller farms originally owned by Israel, Jacob, and Nathan Herrick, and Ezra Witter, whose place included the location of the mansion of Dr. Henry Rose. He sold to Jasper Traver 60 acres including the tavern property at Kinney's Corners. Henry Rose was educated a physician but has been a good farmer instead, a successful wool-grower and fruit culturist. Both John N. and Henry Rose have been men of retiring and modest character who have aimed to discharge well their duties in society and in home life. They have schewed ambitious participation in politics and preferred the quiet enjoyment of a refined social life. In their advanced years they have the undivided respect of all who share their acquaintance.
