EDWARD NORMAN

Born in Hudson, N. Y., in 1806, removed to this town (North Adams, Mass.) in 1830, and opened the first drug store in the place, selling out in 1859 to W. H. Griswold and Dr. Lawrence, both now deceased.

Dr. Norton married Miss L. M. Putnam, a great granddaughter of Gen. Israel Putnam, by whom he had two children: Martha M., wife of Samuel Keyes of this village, and Emily N., wife of L. M. Hayden.

He was one of the oldest F. & A. Masons in the town.

He died May 28, 1874.
