SAMUEL VAN ORDEN.

DIED: Suddenly, on the morning of the 10th inst, at his residence in this village, Samuel Van Orden, Esq., counsellor at law, aged 31 years, eight months. The deceased was one of those of whom the simplest enumeration of his virtues would be the proudest memorial. In his private attachments and in all his transactions as a man and a citizen, he was open, honorable, without guile and without reproach. His was also one of the kindest of hearts. The sympathies which bound him to his friends and to his family were of that peculiar and delicate nature which one loved to remember and cherish. It is the sundering of such ties as these which brings with it a deep grief and anguish. But there is a religious beauty in the reflection, though it be painful to dwell upon, that he has gone from among us in the bloom of his morning, honored, respected and lamented by all men.
