VAN BUREN, John, a Representative from New York; born in Kingston, Ulster County, N. Y., May 13, 1799; studied law, was admitted to the bar, and commenced practice in Kingston, N. Y.; member of the State assembly in 1831; judge of Ulster County 1836-1841; elected as a Democrat to the Twenty-seventh Congress (March 4, 1841-March 3, 1843); resumed the practice of law; district attorney of Ulster County 1846-1850; died in Kingston, N. Y., January 16, 1855; interment in the Old Houghtaling Cemetery. 1818 p. 1641, still 1891

JOHN VAN BEUREN, Jun., 1818, a resident of Kingston, N.Y., was a member of the Philomathen Society. (Died: 1855)
