Died: On board the brig Plymouth, from Leghorn, (arrived at Philadelphia) on the 2nd inst., of consumption, Mr. William E. Rapelye, a native of Fishkill, N. Y. He had made the voyage to the south of Europe with the hope of improving his health. Mr. R. was a gentleman highly esteemed by all on board the vessel. After the performance of the usual ceremonies, his remains were committed to the deep, in lat. 33,30, long. 54.
