Teacher. Studied Law and was admitted to the Bar, but did not practice. Principal Griffith Academy, Springville, N. Y., 1831-33; of Union Lit. Society, Belleville, N. Y., 1834-36; of Aurora Academy, East Aurora, N. Y., 1838-47; Superintendent Cincinnati, Ohio, High School, 1847-53.

Superintendent Public Schools, Circleville, O., 1862-69, School Commissioner, State of Ohio, 1853-57.

President Ohio State Teachers' Assoc., 1849–50; an organizer of the American Assoc. for the Advancement of Education, at Philadelphia, Dec. 17, 1849; Member of its Executive Committee until 1854.

Author of numerous important papers published in "Proceedings of Ohio State Teachers' Assoc.," and of lectures, etc., delivered before Teachers' Institutes and Associations in Ohio.

HIRAM H. BARNEY, 1830, of Ellisburgh, N.Y., was a member of the Adelphic Society.

Mary Ann Elliot, daughter of Matthew and Mary Ann( Farrand) Elliot, was born at Kent, Conn. Jan. 16 1807. She married August 6 1831, Hiram H. Barney. He graduated at Union College, in 1830 and was a lawyer. They settled in Cincinnati, Ohio, where he was commissioner of common schools of the state of Ohio. They had three children:

- 3. Howard \$b. Sept. 10 1840.

Hiram H. Barney began service as principal (of the Aurora, N.Y. Academy) in May, 1838............ Mr. Barney remained in charge of the academy until 1847, and under his strict but vigorous management it attained wide celebrity. He moved to Ohio in 1847, and was subsequently Commissioner of Schools of that State.
