Son of Thomas and Rachael Hopper Newcomb, was born in Pleasant Valley, New York, July 30, 1804; was graduated at Union College, 1828; studied law, obtained his license, and settled at Syracuse, New York; some years afterward, he removed to Waterloo, Seneca County, New York, in the same State, where he has since been largely engaged in a foundry; he married Aug. 31, 1836, Mary Richardson, daughter of William F, and Sarah, born at Auburn, New York, May 5, 1817.
