

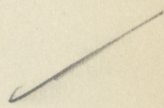
*WILLIAM CURTIS BOYCE. 1830

Born Feb. 14, 1809, at Homer, N. Y.; Died Sept. 23, 1887, at Lockport, Niagara Co., N. Y.

Entered from Cortland, N. Y. . . . A. B. 1830.

Clergyman and Teacher. Studied Law at Lockport, N. Y., and at Transylvania Law School, Kentucky; admitted to the Bar but did not engage in practice; Principal Cayuga Lake Sem., Aurora, N. Y., 1832-34; Student at Auburn Theol. Sem., 1834-36; Ordained by Presbytery of Cayuga, 1837; Pastor at Westford, N. Y., (installed Sept. 30, 1838), 1838-40; Fredonia, Unadilla, and Richfield Springs, N. Y., 1840-46; Maine, N. Y., 1850-55; Teacher at Aurora, N. Y., 1856-59; and then engaged in fruit culture at Lockport, N. Y., until his death.

WILLIAM C. BOYCE, '30,

was born at Homer, N. Y., February 14th, 1809. He was graduated at Auburn Theological Seminary in 1837. He preached at Westford four years, supplied the pulpit at Fredonia, Unadilla, Richfield Springs, Lockport, Maine and Aurora. His political sentiments were Republican. He died at Lockport, September 23rd, 1887.
