LEE, Moses Lindley, a Representative from New York;
born in Minisink, N. Y., May 29, 1805; pursued classical
studies; was graduated from Union College in 1827 and from
the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Western New York
in 1830; practiced medicine in Fulton, Oswego County, N. Y.;
postmaster at Fulton 1840-1844; member of the State house
of representatives in 1847 and 1848; served in the State senate
in 1855; elected as a Republican to the Thirty-sixth Congress
(March 4, 1859-March 3, 1861); resumed the practice of
medicine in Fulton, N. Y.; died in Petersburg, Va., May 19,
1876; interment in Mount Adnah Cemetery, Fulton, N. Y.
