DIED: At the residence of Col. John Tighlman, near Ceukeville, Md., on the 29th of October, Andrew Peters, son of the Hon. John T. Peters of this city, aged 20 years. He received the degree of A.B. at Union College in July last, and was admitted ad eundem at the last commencement of Washington College. He distinguished himself in his college course by his excellent scholarship, good moral character and gentlemanly deportment. His untimely death will be deplored by all who knew him, but more especially by those who have thus seen his parents deprived of a chief solace in their declining years. (Hartford Times)
