## ANDREW GIFFORD WYLIE

In the following year (1841), Rev. Andrew Gifford Wylie became pastor of the congregation (Reformed Presbyterian Church, Duanesburgh), and was ordained and installed August 29, 1841. He was born in the City of New York, and was educated at the University of Pennsylvania, In Philadelphia. He remained for nearly thirty years, ending his labors here with the close of 1870, when he accepted a call to a church in Philadelphia. In 1880 he was called to a church in Cincinnati, O., where he remained until his death in December, 1884.
