This Church was organized by a committee ap-
pointed by the Classis of New York, on the second
Wednesday in December, 1823, when Messrs.
Luke Hinchcliff, and Stephen Hasbrouck, M.D., 1815
were installed elders, and Messrs. John Butler and
James Smith, deacons. Subsequently James
Smith was chosen clerk, and Leonard W. Kip,
Esq., treasurer.

In the year 1835, about eleven years after the organization of the Broome Street Church, Mr. Kip resigned his office as treasurer, that he might give his labors to the Reformed Dutch Church in Ninth street, which was then an infant organization, under the pastoral care of his brother, the Rev.
